## Generic Equivalents and Generic Alternatives

## Know the Difference

The federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires generics to have the same quality, strength, purity and stability as brand name drugs.

**Generic Equivalent:** A generic equivalent is made with the same active ingredients in the same dosage form as a brand name product, and provides the same therapeutic effects as the brand name drug. Not all brand name drugs have generic equivalents, but many do.

**Generic Alternative:** A generic alternative is a drug that may be used to treat the same condition as a brand name drug. However, it may have a different chemical formula and ingredients. Talk to your doctor or pharmacist if you have questions about generic alternatives.
