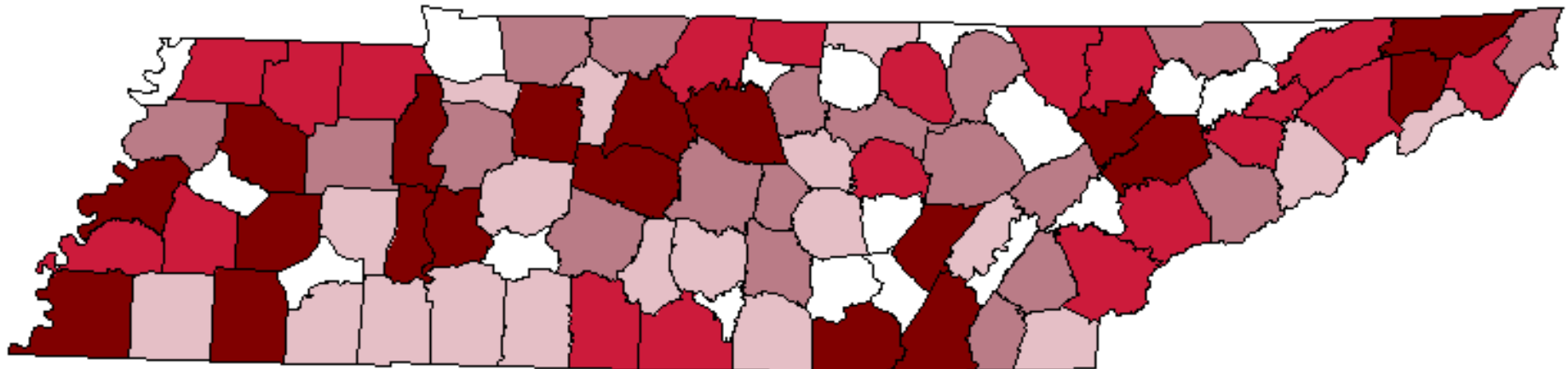
The information chosen compares Memphis health and mortality information to state and Davidson county data.

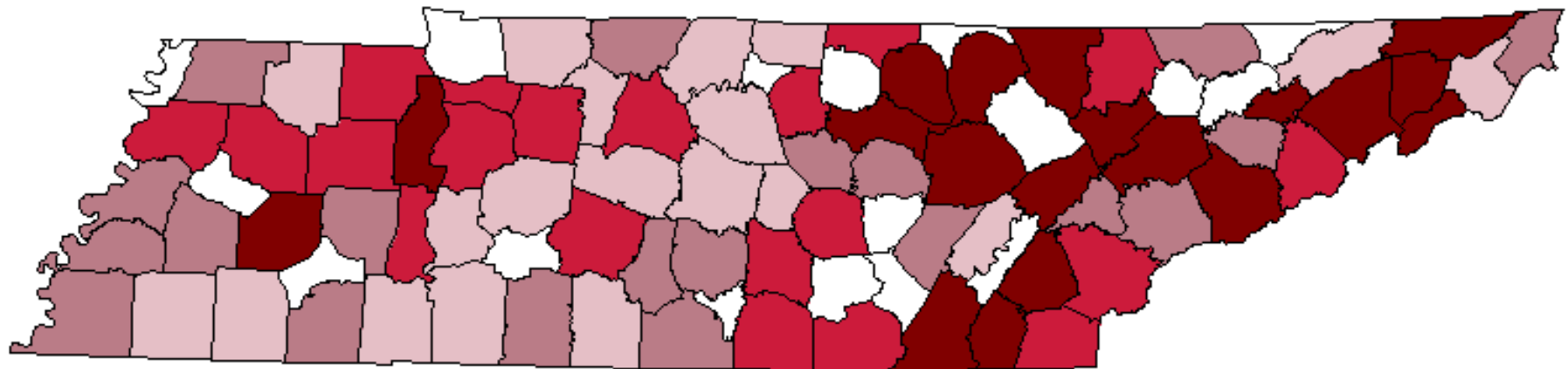

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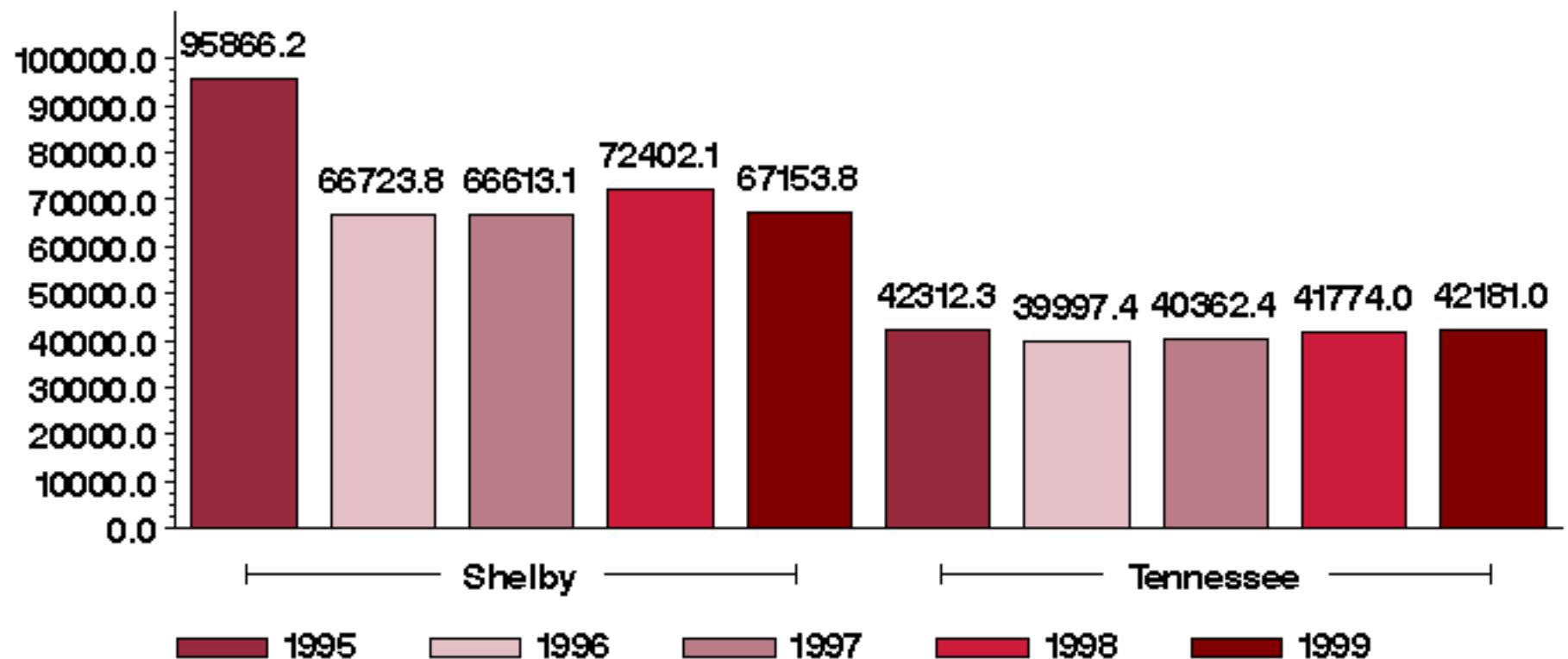

Population per Hospital

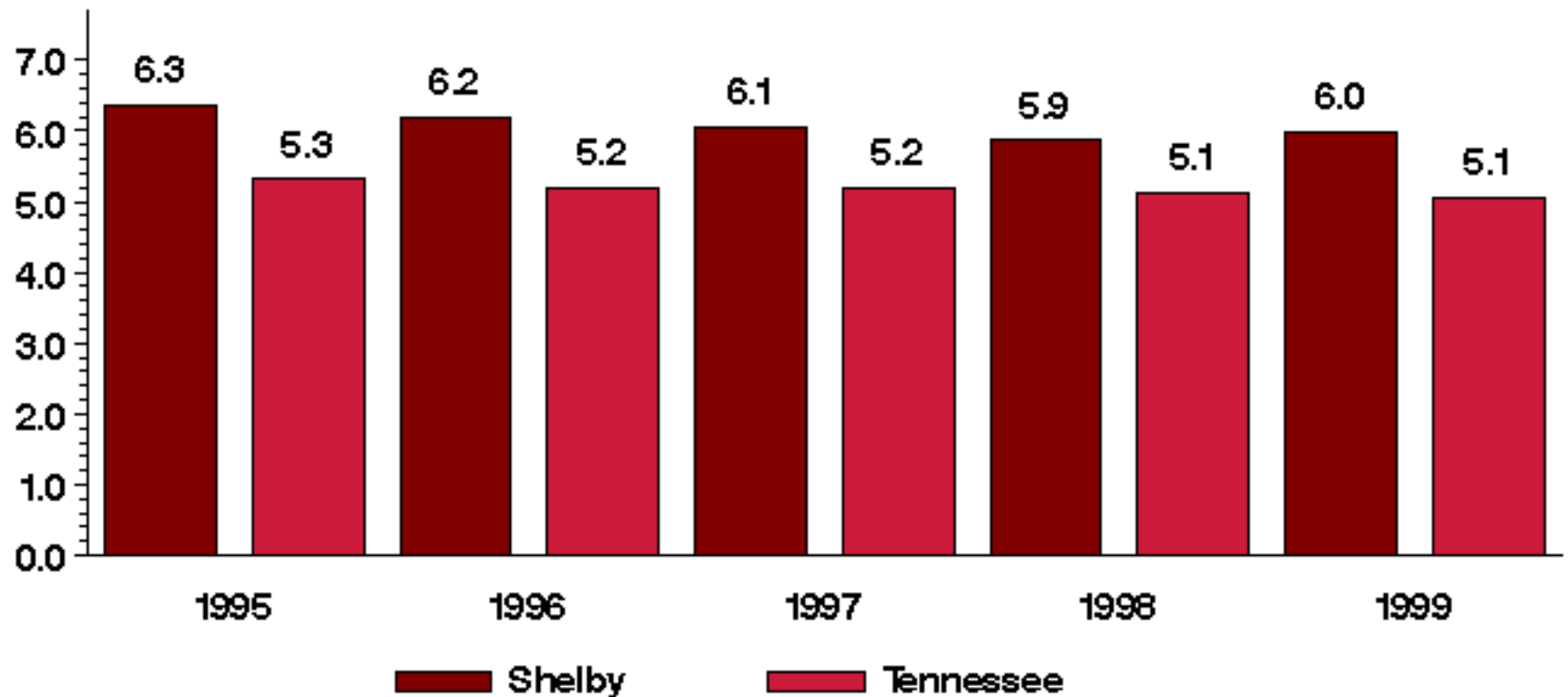

Shelby, 1995 to 1999



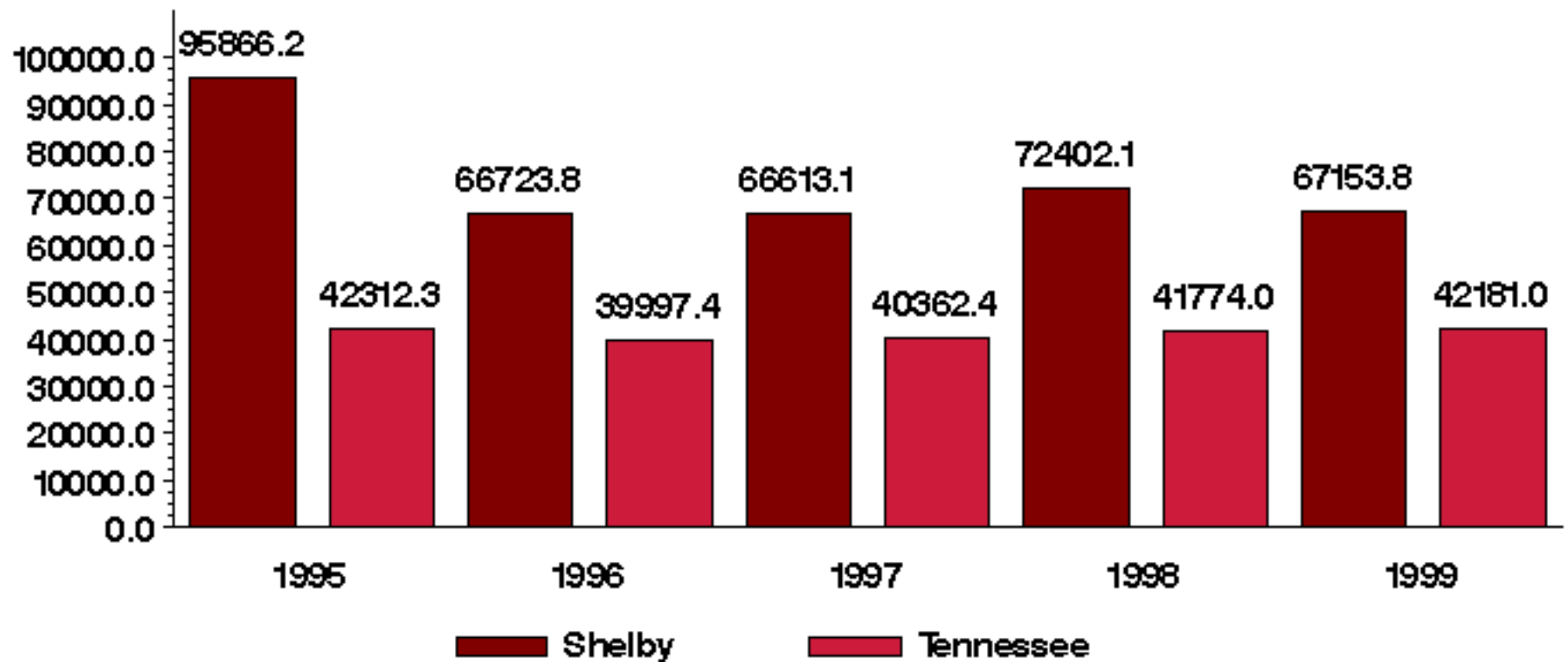

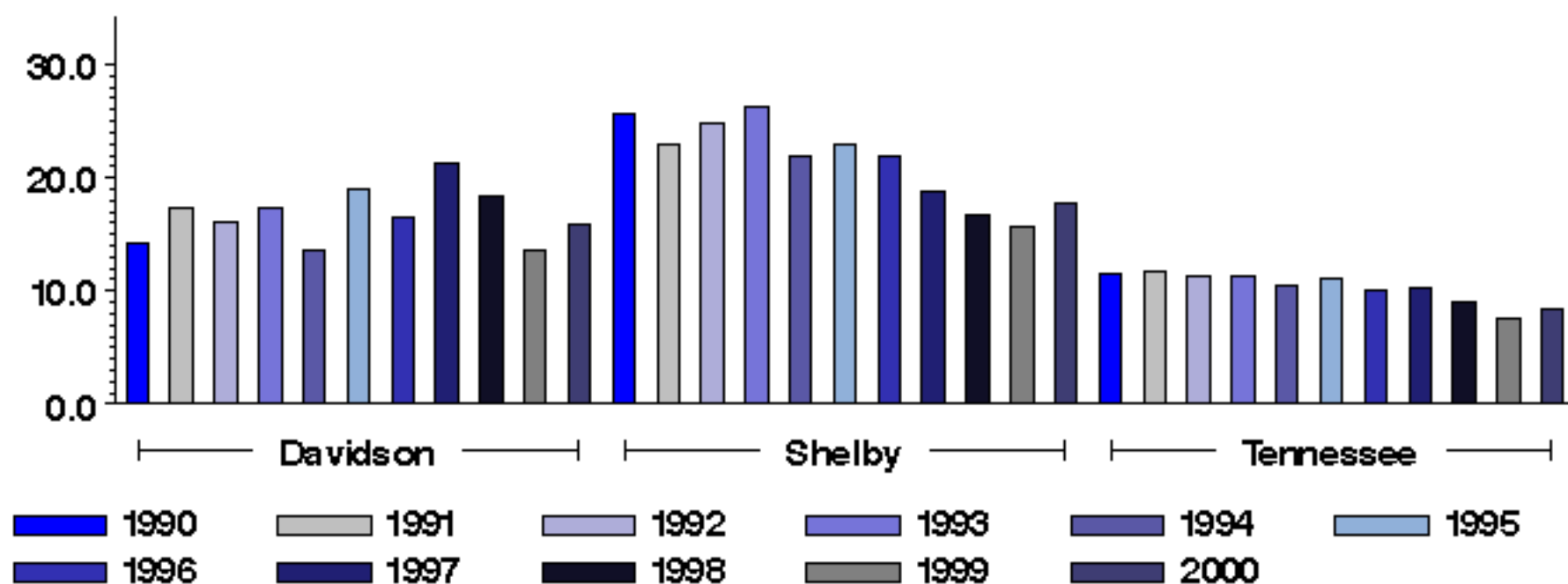

Includes: Race= All, Sex= Both, Ages= <1—85+

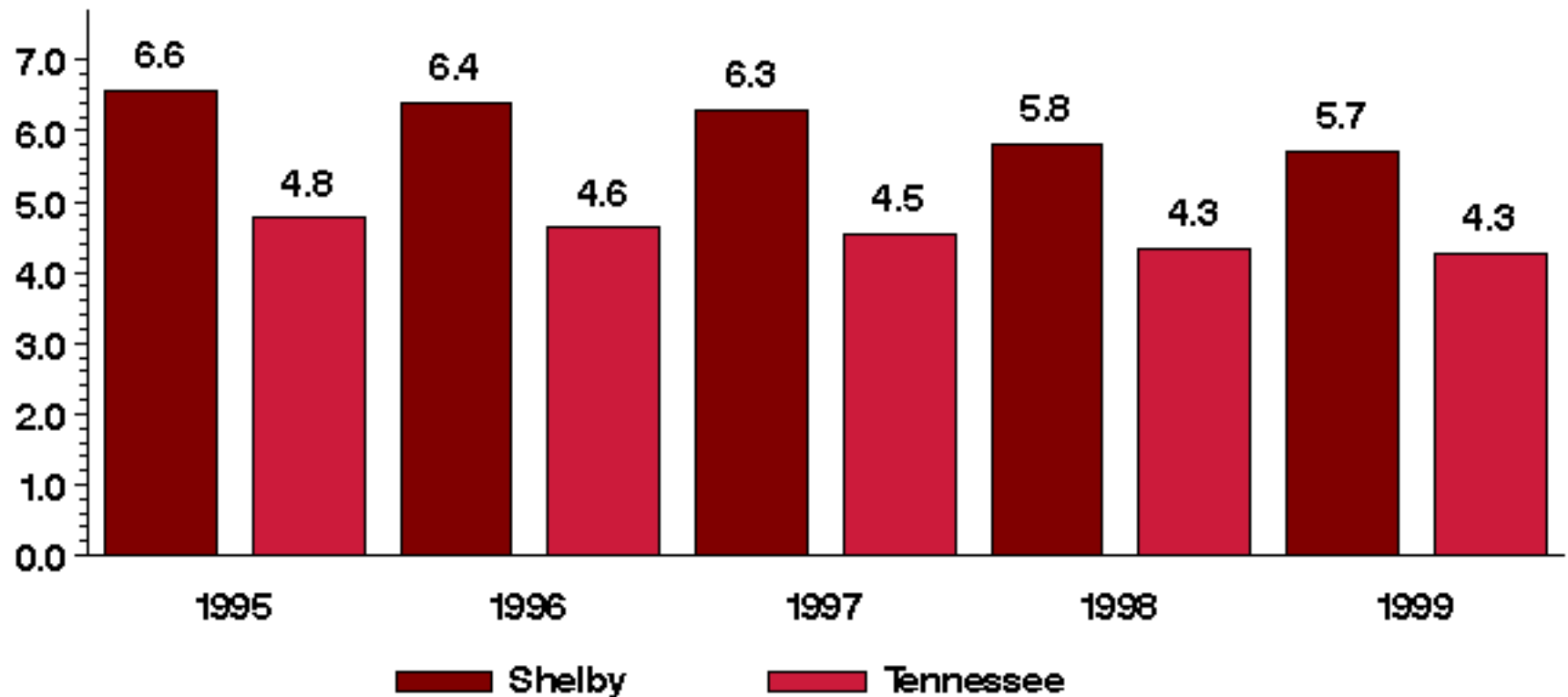

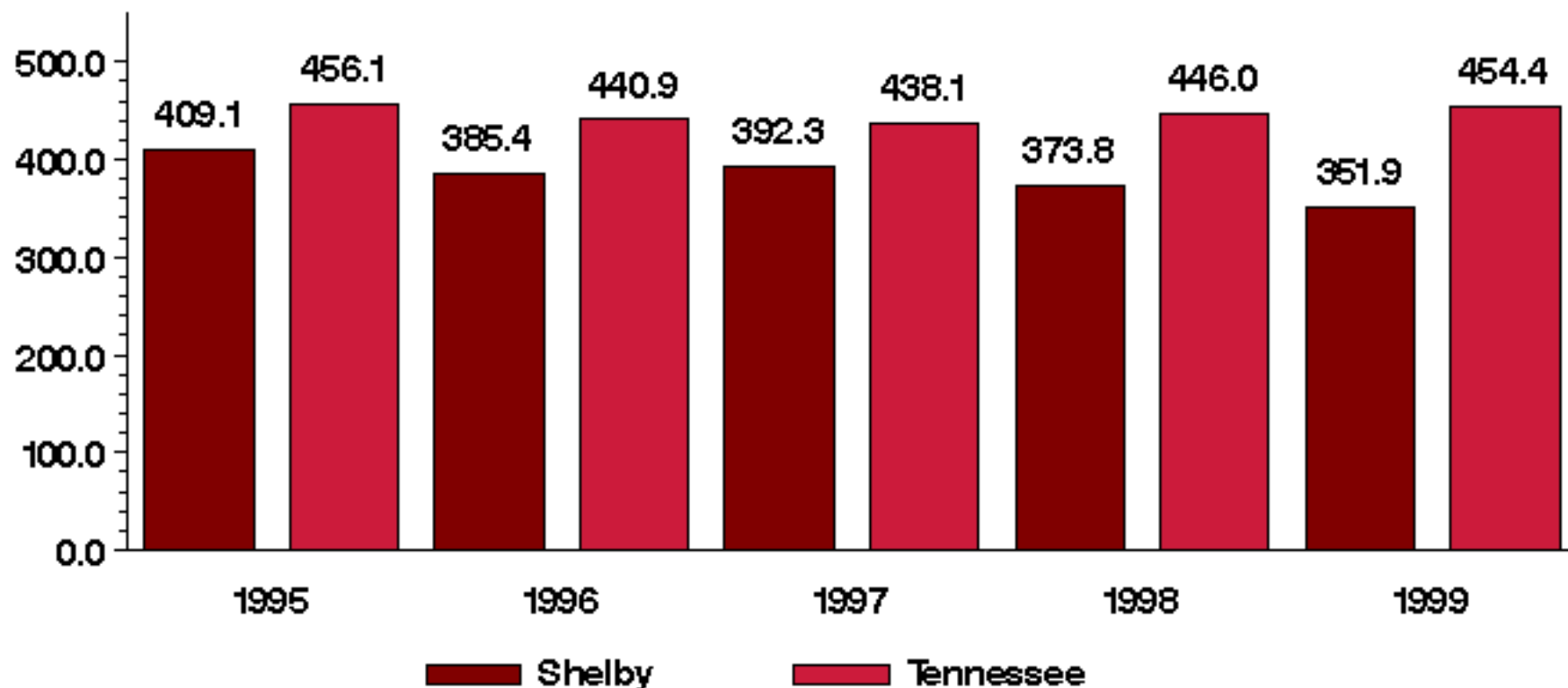
HOSPITALS, TENNESSEE

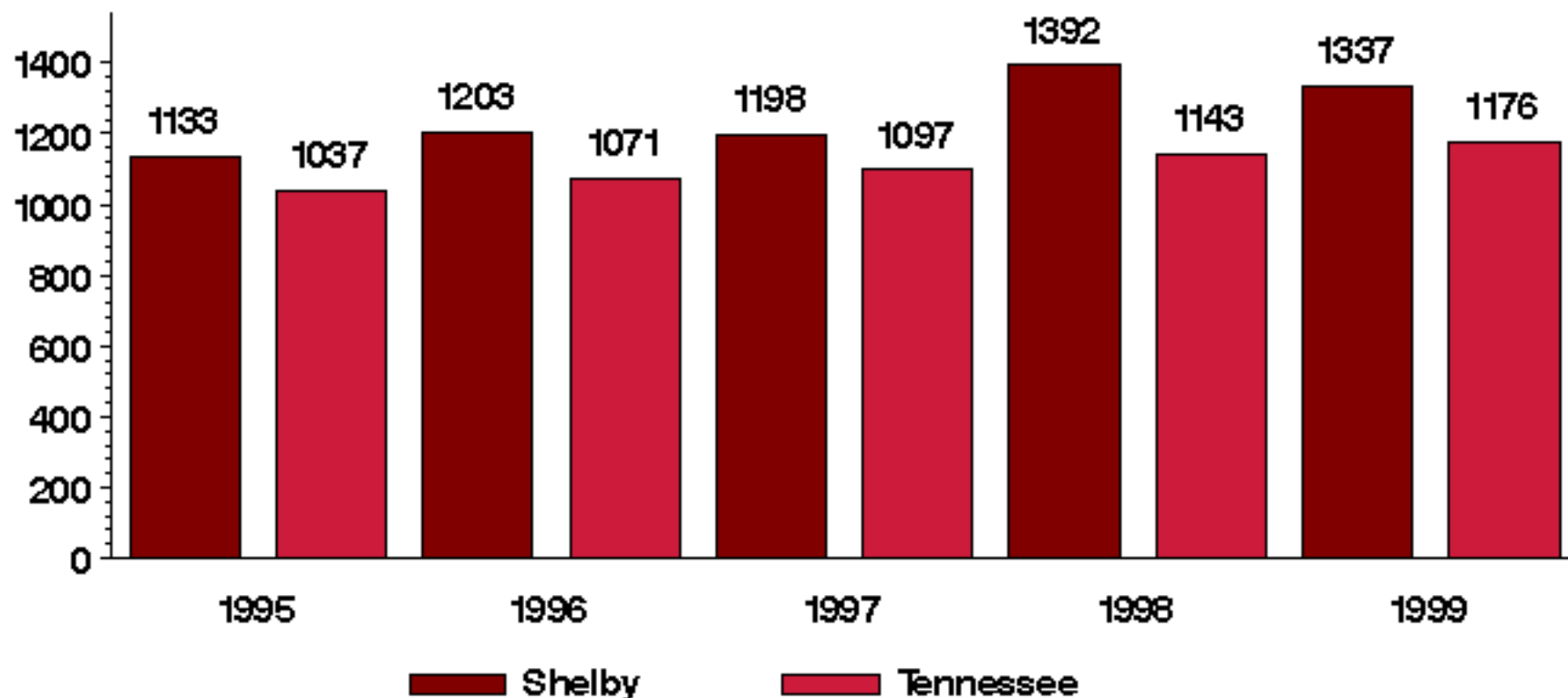
HOSPITALS, TENNESSEE

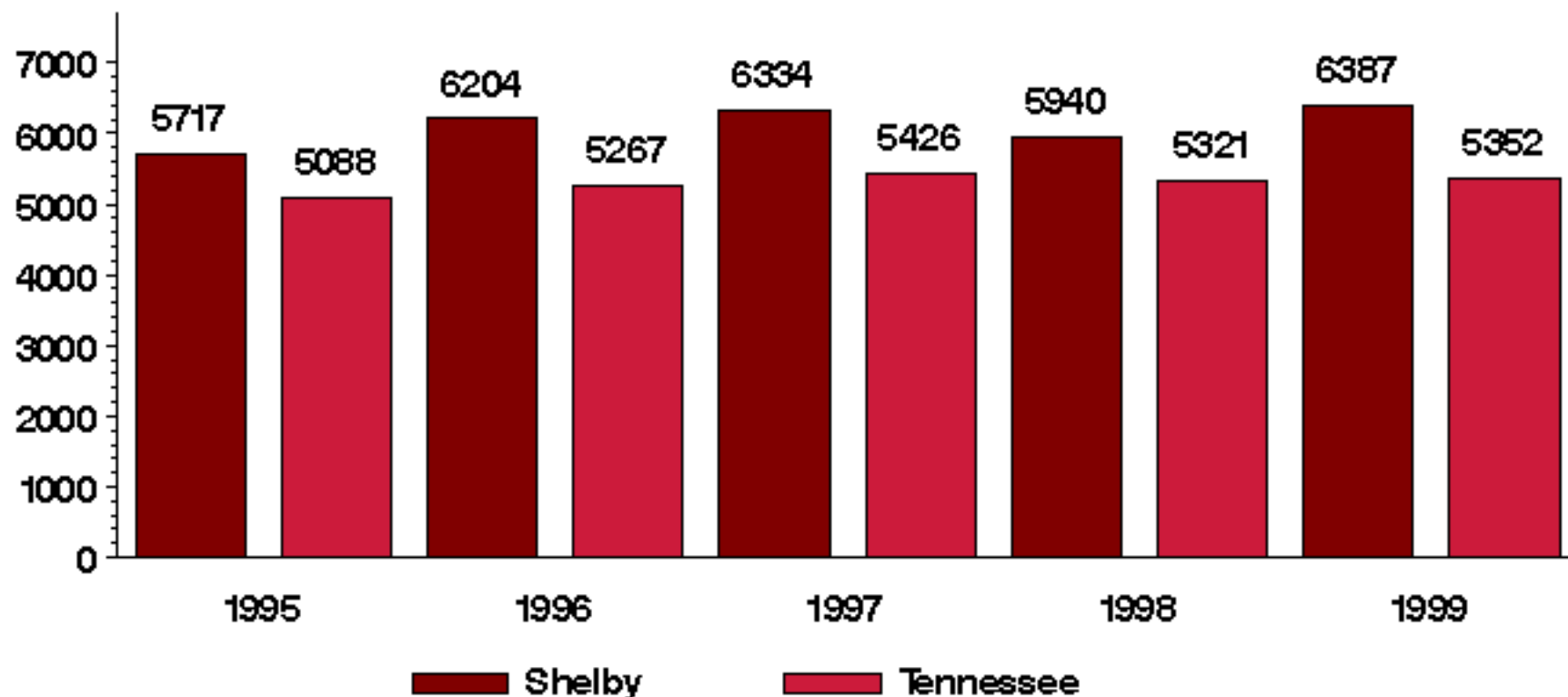
HOSPITALS, TENNESSEE

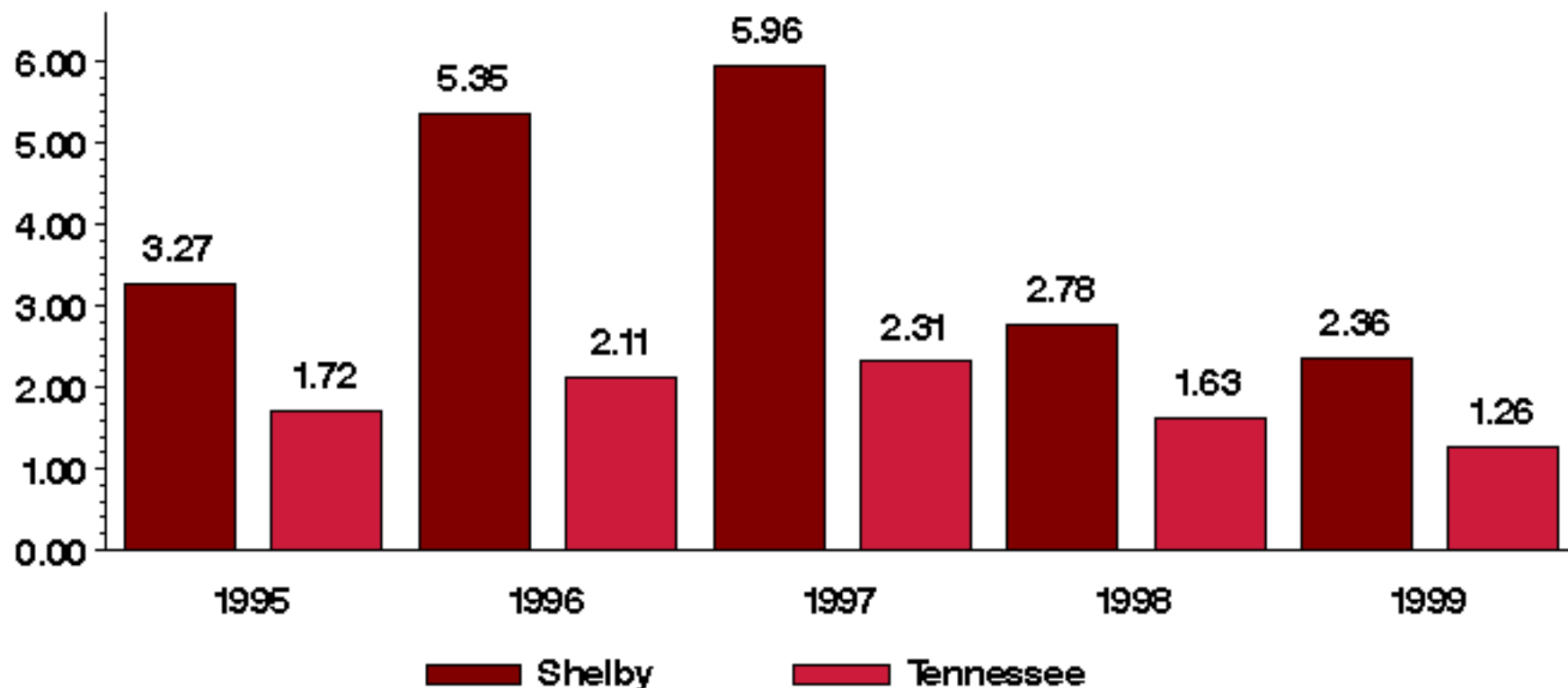

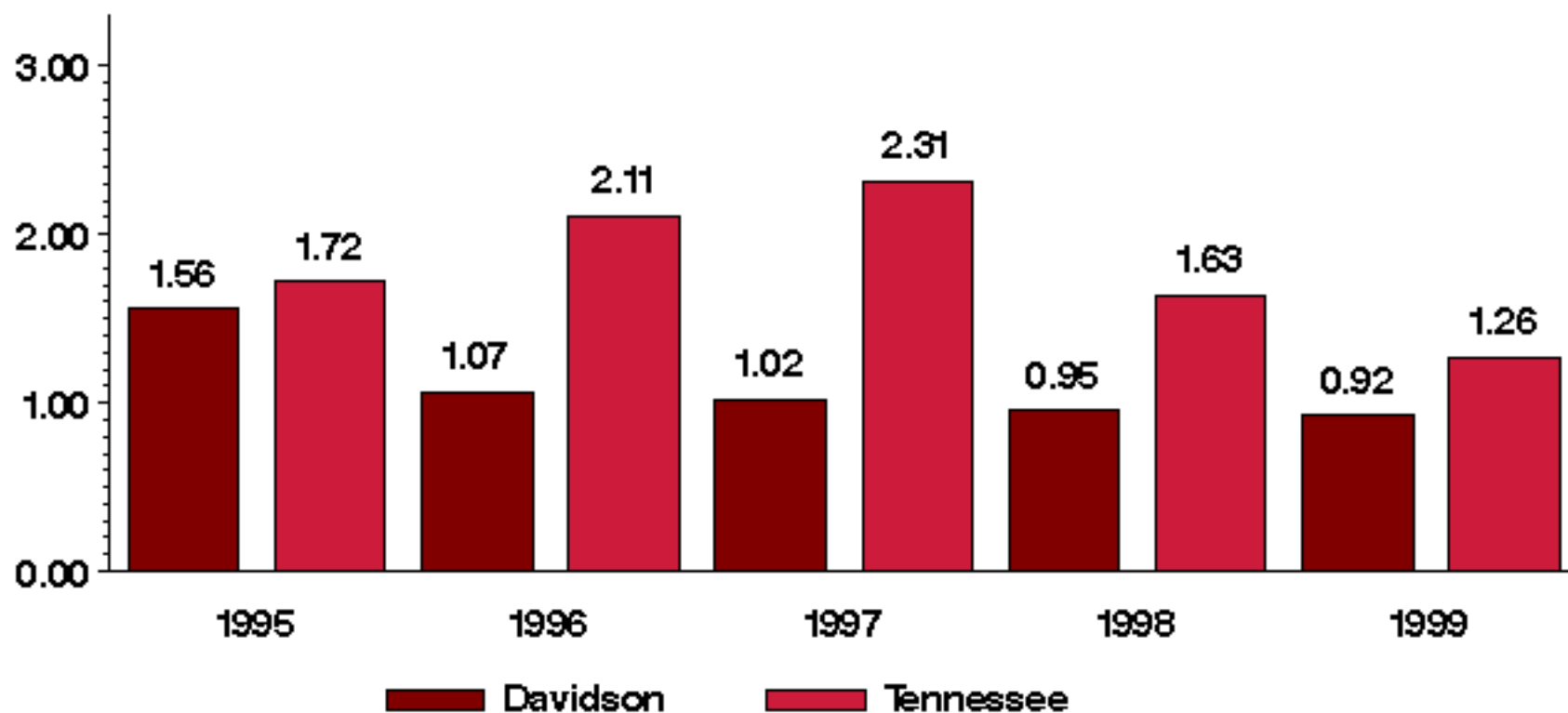

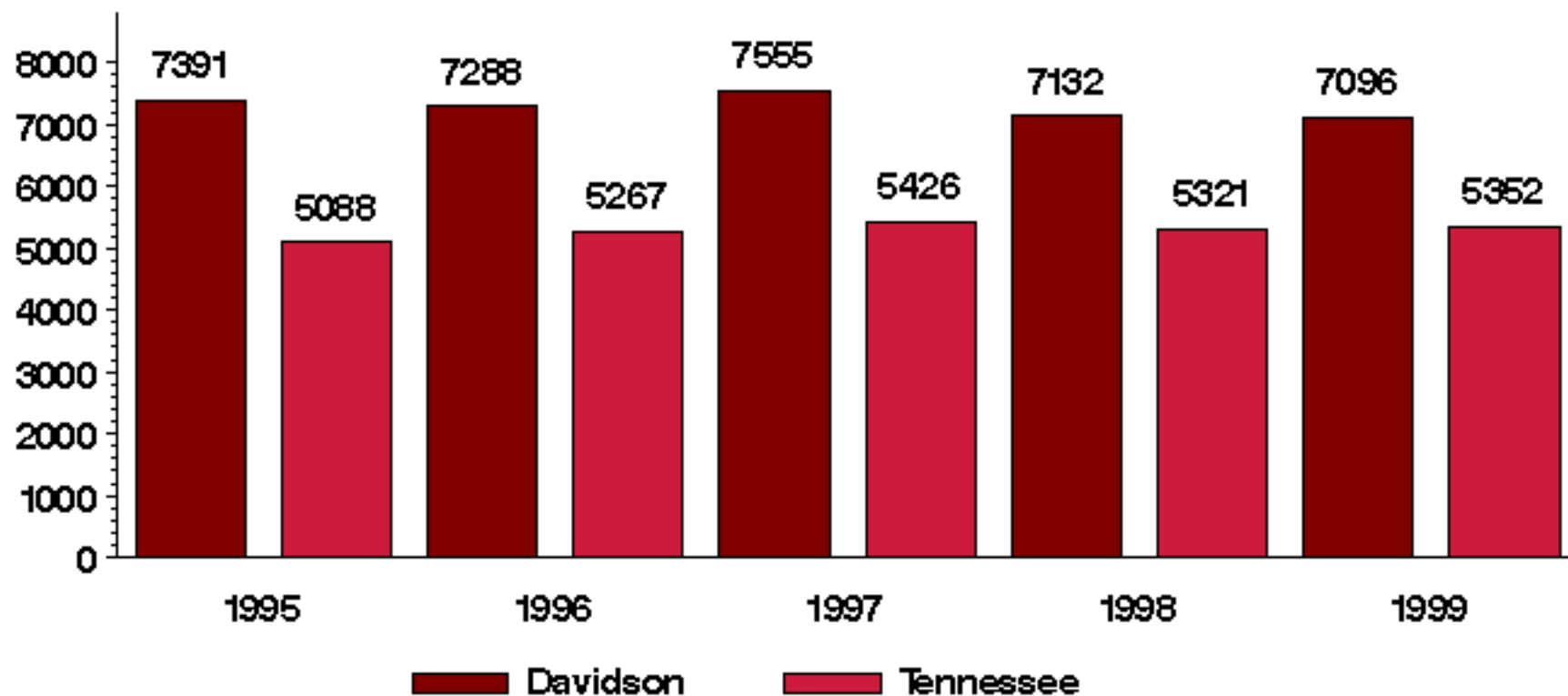

Davidson, 1995 to 1999



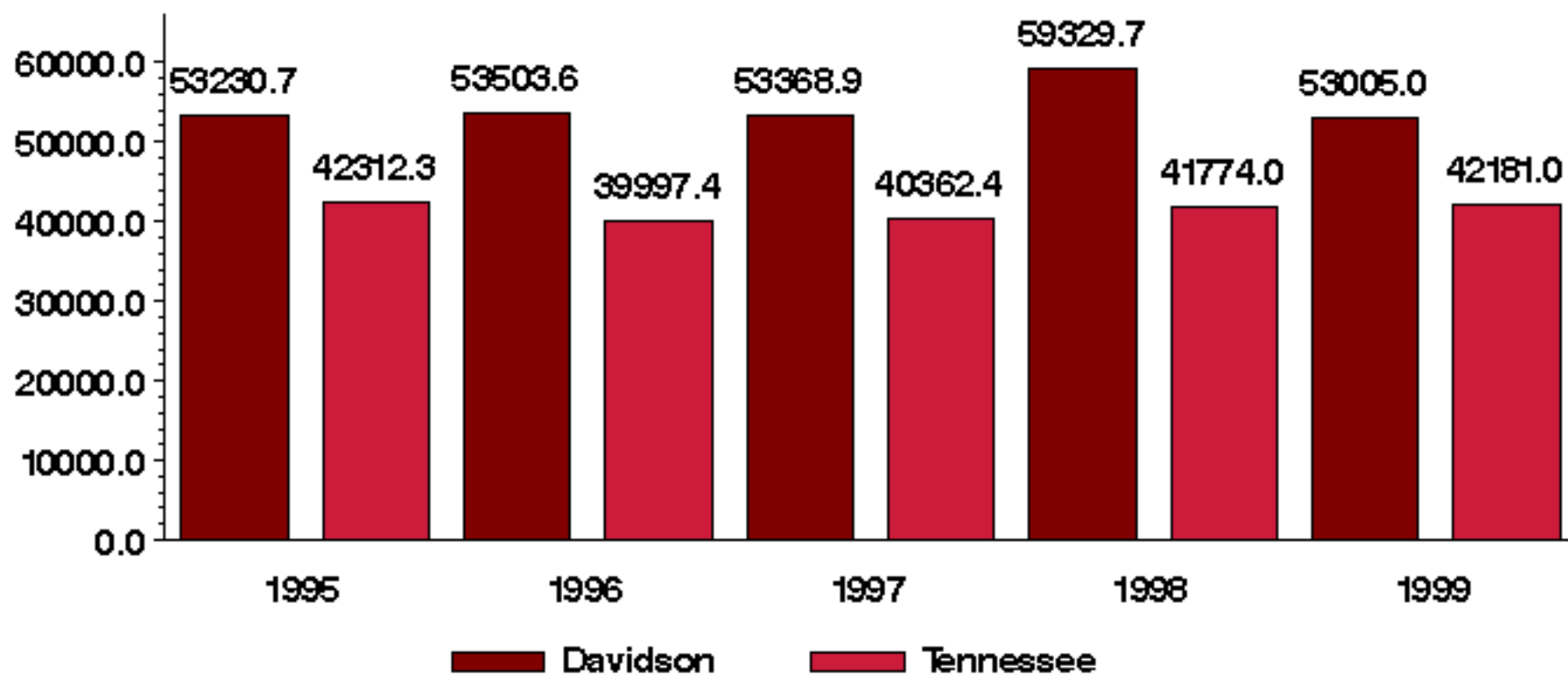

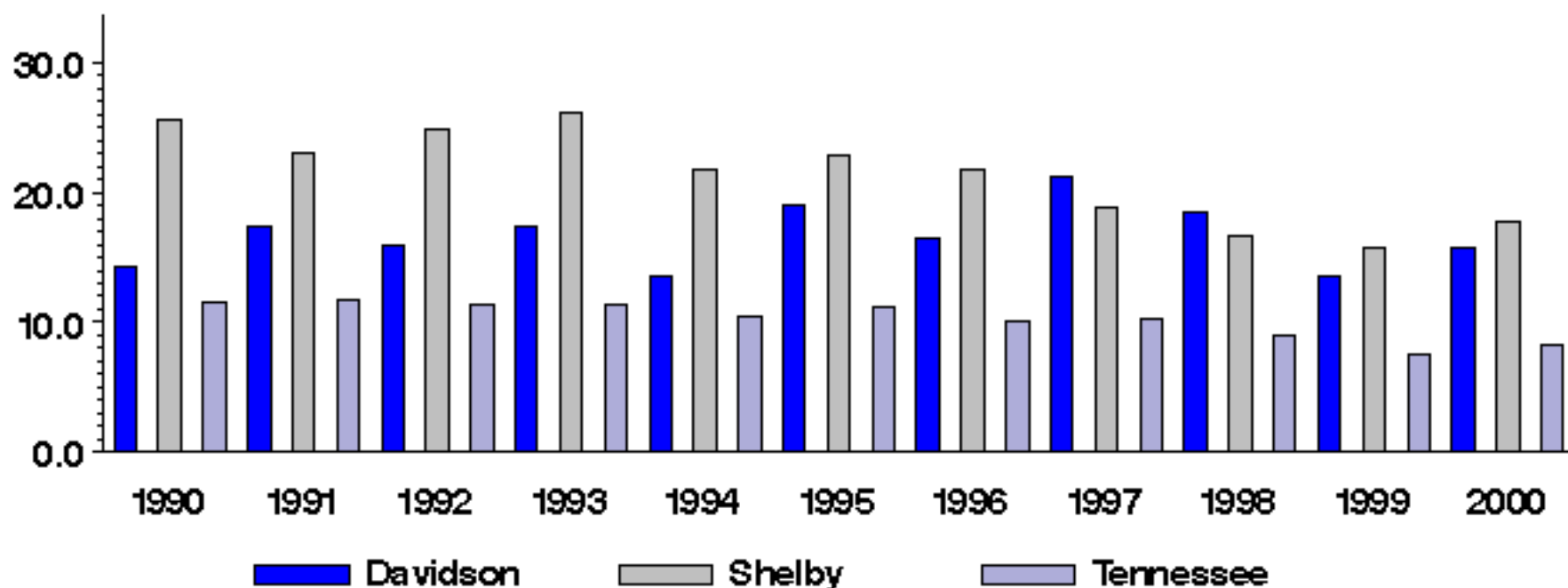
